**WHAT:** A public poll-site election for a board seat on the Skagit Conservation District Board of Supervisors

**WHEN:** 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. Tuesday, March 20, 2018.

**WHERE:** 2021 E. College Way, Mount Vernon, WA. Conference Room

**WHO:** You can vote if you live in Skagit County and are a registered Washington voter!

**HOW:**

- Vote in person on March 20 or
- request a mail-in ballot by 4 pm Tuesday, March 6, 2018 by calling 360-428-4313 or emailing [skagitcd@skagitcd.org](mailto:skagitcd@skagitcd.org)

**Candidates** must be registered voters residing in Skagit County and may be required to own land or operate a farm. The candidate filing deadline is 4 p.m. Tuesday, February 20, 2018. No further candidate filings may be accepted.
